Furthermore, part-time students are not entitled to special academic and advising services. The students are responsible for meeting the requirements of the syllabus for their part-time course of study.

(2) With regard to examination regulations, part-time semesters are counted as half semesters. If a student completes more than 18 credit points in one semester, it counts as a full semester. Consequently, the prescribed timeline for full-time students, as provided in the study and examination regulations, are doubled for semesters completed as part-time semesters.

Other examination dates and deadlines remain unaffected. Part-time students have the same membership status as full-time students.

Part-time study has no effect on the university fees due each semester, e.g. semester contribution, administrative fee contribution, other fees and legal provisions regarding long-term study fees.

(3) Students are required to submit their application for enrolment as a part-time student prior to the semester in question. It must be submitted to the Student Administration Office no later than the end of the re-registration period for the upcoming part-time semester.
